The Turning Point Suffragist Memorial Association (TPSMA) invites college and university students across the country to participate in TPSMA's campaign to raise awareness about the history of the women's suffrage movement, and to help the organization raise funds to construct a national memorial honoring the brave women who stood up and spoke out on behalf of their rights and ours. The *TPSM University Affiliates Program* urges students to assume an active role in TPSMA and encourages student involvement and activism on U.S. college and university campuses nationwide.

Students can participate in the Affiliates program as individual TPSMA members or as part of a registered campus group. Annual dues, once paid, secure the new Affiliate's membership, along with opportunities to participate in fundraising events and awareness-raising campaigns. As Affiliates, students will be invited to enter contests, submit content for publication on TPSMA's blog and social media pages, help educate their peers about women's rights and history, and reflect on the women's suffrage movement in a variety of ways.
